<u>Issue:</u> Three failing cases occur with double-quotation marks. A double-quotation mark will be trimmed if it is the first character in a field, or if it is the last character in a field; also if the field starts *and* ends with a double-quotation mark, then the first instance is kept but the last is trimmed.

#6478

<u>Issue:</u> This issue has been fixed so that picklists of more than 1,000 list items will be displayed in picklist dropdown boxes. However, picklists of more than 30,000 list items may experience performance degradation, and picklists of more than 60,000 items may not display properly or cause an error to appear in KwikTag clients when using the picklist dropdown.
