System Requirements:

KwikTag T3 is compatible with Hyper-V or VMWare for virtual installations and requires a Windows Server 2008 R2 retail, OEM, or volume license. If you buy hardware from KwikTag, a Windows Server 2008 R2 standard, enterprise, and data center license is required. The minimum required resolution is 1280 x 960 and the recommended resolution is 1920 x 1080.

KwikTag currently supports the following versions of Microsoft Dynamics ERP solutions:

- Microsoft Dynamics GP 10, GP2010 and R2
- Microsoft Dynamics NAV 5 SPI, 2009R2 Classic and RTC SPI (Support for NAV 5 does not support KwikTag Client workflow capabilities due to the lack of Navision Web Services in NAV 5)
- Microsoft Dynamics AX 2009 and AX2012

KwikTag currently supports the following Microsoft Office and SharePoint versions:

- Microsoft Office Suite 2007 and 2010
- Microsoft Office SharePoint Server 2007 and 2010 MOSS
- Microsoft Office 365 is supported for dragging and dropping of email and Office documents. The KwikTag SharePoint Connector, however, does not have a defined and secure network connection path to hosted SharePoint servers in Microsoft data centers.

New Features/Enhancements:

KwikTag Client:

EZ-219: Upload Page - Add a browse button

Added a button on the upload page to browse the file system and select a document.

EZ-198: Vendor Filter - enter key to submit

The enter key can be used to submit selections on the vendor filter screen.

EZ-145: Simple search handle "GLCode=" search

Simple search of GL codes has been improved to allow for entry of "GL Code =" and then entering all or part of the GL code

EZ-152: Remove the 1000 and 500 default document counts from the preferences list

The option for displaying 1000 or 500 documents has been removed from the preferences list.

EZ-153: Enter key on Submit in Simple Search

The option to use the enter key to submit a simple search has been added.

EZ-225: Simple Searches performance improvement

Simple searching taking unexpectedly long time to complete. Results are now limited to 500 records.





EZ-224: Add the drawer name to the edit view panel

Identify what drawer a document is part of by displaying the drawer name on the edit view panel.

EZ-173: Arrows on barcode numbers

Arrows have been added to the barcode field to allow the user to increment or decrement the barcode when tagging

Resolved Issues History

SF Case Number: 32138: Image remains visible in right-hand view pane after deleting last document in drawer

Image remained visible in view pane after deleting last document in drawer in work queue.

SF Case Number: 31943,32159: Page orientation not following the placement of barcode

(Applicable to = Platform) The document orientation was not corresponding to the placement of the barcode on scanned documents in web client.

SF Case Number: 31854: HR Education missing "Education" data from Mapping

(Applicable to = AX2012) Tagging from "Education" didn't capture "Education" field data from Education screen.

SF Case Number: 31371: Unable to view documents when company has ampersand

(Applicable to = GP) Documents were unable to be viewed in the connector when a company name included an ampersand.

SF Case Number: 31908, 31707, 31874: Incorrect Vendor Name in Email Approvals

(Applicable to = KwikTag Client) The notification email sent to the approver is displaying an incorrect vendor name

SF Case Number: 31121: Currency fields do not pull back correct records for >, >=, <, or <= in global search

(Applicable to =KwikTag Client) Currency fields do not pull back correct records for >, >=, <, or <=.

SF Case Number: 31836: When Unified Client enabled, Fails to Return Documents

(Applicable to = GP2010R2) Enabling the unified client (KwikTag Client) for GP, the results of previously tagged documents are not returned.

SF Case Number: 31842: E-Covers not printed

(Applicable to = NAV2009 Classic/RTC and AX2012) When selecting to tag with an e-cover, the current barcode is used instead and an e-cover is not printed.

SF Case Number 32090: Unhandled Exception Error in KwikTag Client

(Applicable to = KwikTag Client) Customer receives an Unhandled Exception when selecting documents in the Payables Transaction Entry drawer where there are document associations.

SF Case Number: 31843: Disabled users partially functional in AX2012

(Applicable to =AX2012) Users disabled in KwikTag are still partially functional if the integrate0d user has authenticated prior to being disabled.

SF Case Number: 31853: HR Benefits missing "Benefits Name" data from Mapping

(Applicable to = AX2012) Tagging doesn't capture "Benefits Name" data from Benefits Screen.

SF Case Number 31908: Incorrect Vendor Name in Email Approvals

When emails were sent to approvers the vendor ID was correct but the name was not.
